

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Councilmember Herbert Tate in his general report to the Tribal Council for his District reports that there are sewer back-up problems in Canyon Day and sewerage disposal problems in the town of McNary; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember Nelson Ethelbah of the same District elaborates on the sewage problems to the Tribal Council, having personal knowledge of the sewerage treatments and disposal system in McNary and Canyon Day; and

WHEREAS, the Council is of the opinion that Mr. Ethelbah should investigate the matter and report back his findings to the Tribal Council; and Mr. Ethelbah agreeing to conduct the same.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that Councilman Nelson Ethelbah research the sewerage back-up problems in Canyon Day and the condition of the sewerage system in McNary and report back to the Council the results of his investigation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it hereby requests that Mr. Vic Byerly of the Environmental Health Dept., Indian Health Service in Whiteriver, cooperate and assist Mr. Ethelbah in his investigation and review of the sewerage disposal problems in Canyon Day and McNary.

The foregoing resolution was on May 15, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
