

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

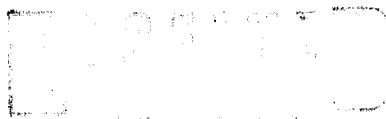
WHEREAS, there is general concern amongst the Tribal Council Members in respect to the adequacy of street lighting in the town of Whiteriver; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Tribal Council that if the Commercial businesses install street lighting that it will create a more favorable night environment for members of the general public and will reduce vandalism and crimes against persons and property.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that the commercial businesses in the town of Whiteriver install street lights on the leased property and that these lights be maintained in order to carry out the position said forth in this resolution.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Council Secretary to distribute this resolution to tribal and non-tribal businesses in the town of Whiteriver.

The foregoing resolution was on May 15, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat 984).
