

RESOLUTION NO. 86-140

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Delores Alsenay has requested Tribal Council assistance in granting a right-of-way so that essential utility lines including water pipes can be constructed to her mobile home located in Yucca Flat; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that there is ample room for the construction of utility lines to Mrs. Alsenay's home without transgressing on Mr. Spencer Alchesay's land as he has expressed some concern in respect to potential damage caused by trenching; and


WHEREAS, in the event it is absolutely necessary to cross any part of Mr. Alchesay's land for the purpose of constructing the utility lines to Mrs. Alsenay's mobile home, any damage or excess excavation to or on Mrs. Alchesay's land will be completely restored to the state existing prior to said excavation.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants a right-of-way for the purpose of constructing water and other utility lines to the mobile home for Mrs. Delores Alsenay.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in the event that it is necessary to cross Mr. Spencer Alchesay's land for the purpose of extending utility lines to Mrs. Alsenay's home, any disturbance or excavation resulting from construction of said utility lines shall be restored to the state existing prior to said excavation.

The foregoing resolution was on May 20, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
