WHEREAS, the Utility Authority of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has presented for Tribal Council consideration and approval a contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs to haul trash for the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has thoroughly reviewed the budget proposal and has determined that the trash hauling proposal will return a positive net profit to the Tribe.



BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the Utility Trash Hauling Proposal presented by the White Mountain Apache Utility Authority for FY 86/87.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorize the Tribal Chairman and in his absence the Vice Chairman and any other necessary tribal employees to sign any and all necessary contracts and documents to carry out the purpose of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on May 20, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
