


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is informed that the Turkey Creek Rodeo Association will be sponsoring its annual community rodeo on May 24, 25, 1986; and
- WHEREAS, during the same dates the Whiteriver Commercial Center will be sponsoring its Memorial Day Carnival; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to prior tribal resolution it has been established that community fund raising activities should not have to compete and should enjoy exclusive dates for their activities; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council having discussed the problems associated with several fundraising functions occurring during the same weekend recognizes that such a situation detracts from each fund-raising activity.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it requests Councilmember Darvin Burnette to negotiate a percentage of profits from the Whiteriver Commercial Center's carnival to be donated to the Turkey Creek Livestock Association Rodeo in order to offset some of the losses of the Turkey Creek Rodeo fundraiser resulting from competition with the Whiteriver Commercial Center Carnival.

The foregoing resolution was on May 21, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
