

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, by previous Council Resolution No. 86-116, the Tribal Council approved a land assignment to David Malone, a tribal member, within the Bureau of Indian Affairs compound; and


WHEREAS, pursuant to said resolution the Tribal Council requested written verification from the Superintendent that the Bureau approved said land assignment, but to date the Tribal Council has not received any such written verification; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Malone has come before the Tribal Council and inquired as to the status of his land assignment.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reaffirms Council Resolution No. 86-116 herein and requests written verification from Superintendent Russell Bradley stating that Mr. Malone has Bureau permission to apply for a homesite within the Bureau compound.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that Superintendent Bradley give this matter his utmost attention so that it does not further delay the processing of a homesite application for Mr. Malone.

The foregoing resolution was on June 11, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
