RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Councilmember, Marjorie Grimes, has advised the Tribal Council of certain alleged problems at the Cibecue Community Day School involving faculty, school board elections, and discipline, and has voiced concern in respect to the wisdom of continuing the Community School pursuant to a 638 Contract; and
- WHEREAS, Councilmember Judy Dehose, a member of the Cibecue Community School Board of Directors, has requested the opportunity to respond in writing at the July regularly scheduled Council Meeting to the issues raised by Mrs. Grimes; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the discussion as to the future of the Cibecue Community Day School should be tabled until the July meeting to provide the opportunity to Councilmember Judy Dehose to respond to the allegations and concerns raised by Mrs. Grimes.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby tables further discussion of the Cibecue Community Day School and the issues raised by Councilmember Marjorie Grimes, until the July regular Tribal Council Meeting.

The foregoing resolution was on June 11, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
