

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the TERO Director, Mr. Leroy Lupe, has failed to comply with a Tribal Council Resolution directing him to investigate certain allegations involving Pinetop Logging and to file a report with the office of the Tribal Chairman within ten (10) days of receipt of said resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Council is further advised that the TERO Director has not performed his duties in carrying out the goals of the Tribal Employment Rights Ordinance, and that he has neglected and otherwise failed to contact non-Indian contractors doing business on the reservation as evidenced by the fact that he has made no contact with paving contractors now operating in the Salt River Canyon who have failed to hire tribal members; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is further advised that proper reports as to compliance with the TERO Ordinance have not been made periodically to the Tribal Council; and


WHEREAS, based on the foregoing, the Tribal Council concludes that the TERO Director should be terminated immediately for cause for failing to effectively carry out the responsibilities of his office.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby terminates Mr. Leroy Lupe as Director of the Tribal Employment Rights Office for cause as evidenced by his failure to effectively carry out the responsibilities of his office, said termination to be effective Monday, June 16, 1986.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Personnel Department to advertise the position of TERO Director immediately.

The foregoing resolution was on June 11, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 4 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of

the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
