


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Tribal Council member Herbert Tate has requested the release of Recreational Land Claims money from the Canyon Day Community Land Claims fund in the amount of \$3,000.00 in order to sponsor 15 youths at the cost of \$200.00 per child, to attend the Byron Scott Basketball Camp; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that funds are available for said purpose and that the communities in support of the sponsorship of said children for the basketball camp.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the appropriation of \$3,000.00 from the Canyon Day Recreational Land Claims fund for the purpose of sponsoring 15 children at \$200.00 per child to attend the Byron Scott Basketball Camp.

The foregoing resolution was on June 11, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
