FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Tribal Council member Gertie Lupe has requested the release of Recreational Land Claims money from the Cedar Creek/Carrizo Community Land Claims fund in the amount of \$8,000.00 in order to sponsor 40 youths at the cost of \$200.00 per child, to attend the Byron Scott Basketball Camp; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that funds are available for said purpose and that the community is in support of the sponsorship of said children for the basketball camp.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the appropriation of \$8,000 from the Cedar Creek/Carrizo Recreational Land Claims fund for the purpose of sponsoring 40 children at \$200.00 per child to attend the Byron Scott Basketball Camp.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby approves the appropriation of \$8,000.00 from the East Fort Recreational Land Claims fund for the purpose of sponsoring 40 children to attend the Byron Scott Basketball Camp.

The foregoing resolution was on June 13, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
