

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, review of prior Central Tribe budgets indicates that there is a need to monitor line items in the respective budgets of the Central Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Administration and Finance is authorized to grant line item adjustments so long as said adjustment does not impact the bottom budget line or exceed said bottom line; and

WHEREAS, if any manager of any tribal department included in its Central Tribe budget wishes to exceed his or her budget, prior Tribal Council approval must be obtained.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that Central Tribe budgets shall be monitored by line item.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Department of Administration and Finance is hereby authorized to grant line item adjustments, but only if said adjustments do not result in expenditures in excess of said budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that if any department manager within Central Tribe desires to exceed his or her overall budget, then prior approval from the Tribal Council should be required.

The foregoing resolution was on JUNE 19, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Trib., pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
