

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, due to prior lack of controls in tribal grants and programs, Central Tribe operations and enterprises regarding the granting of raises to their respective personnel; and

WHEREAS, the present financial restrictions imposed upon the Tribe require that all raises in the foregoing programs, enterprises and Central Tribe be frozen except for those approved in the budget process; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council will review the cash flow status of the Tribe on or about November 1, 1986 in order to determine if it is possible to grant either individual raises or a cost of living increase for tribal employees; and

WHEREAS, an exception to the foregoing freeze on all raises is hereby authorized to those tribal departments financed by grants and contracts if the following conditions are met: 1) the raises are provided for in the budget of the individual department or program financed by grants and contracts; 2) said raises are paid by the grantor; and 3) said departments financed by grants and contracts must pay full indirect costs to the Tribe.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby freezes all raises for personnel in grants, programs, Central Tribe and enterprises except for those approved in the budget process.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it shall review the cash flow status of the Tribe on or about November 1, 1986, for the purpose of determining possible increases.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that grants and contracts may grant raises to their personnel if the following conditions are first met: 1) the raises are provided for in the budget; 2) the raises are paid by the grantor; and 3) the department pays full indirect cost to the Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on JUNE 19, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 5 for and 4 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (o) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
