RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that tribal vehicles continue to be used for personal use by tribal employees assigned said vehicles, contrary to tribal policy and prior resolutions of the Tribal Council; and
- whereas, in the interest of reducing exposure to liability as well as reduction of operating cost and maintenance, the Tribal Council concludes that sanctions should be imposed upon employees who use tribal vehicles for personal use and that department managers shall also be subject to disciplinary action if employees under their supervision use tribal vehicles for personal use; and
- whereas, the prohibition against the personal use of tribal vehicles also prohibits family members from either being operators or passengers of said vehicles, with the exception of the Chairman and Vice-Chairman or except as approved by the Director of Operations, Director of Programs, Director of Administration and Finance, Engineering and by the Chief of Police.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reaffirms its prior policy of prohibiting personal use by employees of tribal vehicles with the exception of the Chairman and Vice-Chairman, and except as approved by the Director of Operations, Director of Programs, Director of Administration and Finance, Engineering and the Chief of Police.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that in the event an employee violates this policy, department managers as well as the employee involved shall be subject to disciplinary action.

The foregoing resolution was on $\frac{\text{JUNE }19}{\text{N}}$, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of $\frac{10}{10}$ for and $\frac{0}{10}$ against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958,

and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
