FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been informed by tribal member Mrs. Nannie Case of the Whiteriver Community that she and her family wish to sponsor a traditional Sunrise Dance during the weekend of August 23, 24, 25, 1986 at the old tribal fairgrounds; and

WHEREAS, it is determined by the Tribal Council that no conflicts exist on said date and permission should be granted.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Mrs. Nannie Case of Whiteriver to sponsor a Sunrise Dance during the weekend of August 22, 23, 24, 1986, at the old tribal fairgrounds and co-sponsored by Tom and Fern Mark.

The foregoing resolution was on July 10, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
