

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE
OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is dedicated to improving and upgrading the economic functioning of all its members, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe Vocational Skill Center is the tribal entity charged with improving and upgrading the employability and employment skills of said members, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe Vocational Skill Center recognizes the specific needs of Tribal enterprises, agencies and programs, and
- WHEREAS, the Skill Center recognizes the special needs of physically, mentally and emotionally handicapped Tribal members, and
- WHEREAS, there is currently a lack of specialized vocational services to assist handicapped Tribal members, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is the the Tribal Governing Body, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council authorizes the Tribal Chairman to negotiate and execute grants, contracts and amendments thereto.

BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribe propose to contract with the Arizona Department of Economic Security/Rehabilitation Services Administration to provide services to handicapped individuals through an Employment Related Program consisting of Work Adjustment/Job Training, Job Development and Placement,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, if funded, the Vocational Skill Center is authorized as the Tribal agency to administer the Employment Related Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribe acknowledges that the contract services do not include SUPPORTED EMPLOYMENT as stated in Resolution No. 86-130 dated and passed May 15, 1986.

The foregoing resolution was on July 10, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe, June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
