

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is informed by Council Member Darvin Burnette that vandalism is occurring on the Community Buildings at East Fork and Seven Mile, therefore, he is requesting funding to cover the costs of installing window shutters on the community buildings to prevent further vandalism; and

WHEREAS, the labor will be donated by Tribal Maintenance and that the Fort Apache Timber Company should be given instruction to donate fifteen (15) pieces of lumber (1" x 12"); and

WHEREAS, materials will be purchased from Tribal Maintenance and Pinetop Lumber Company; the total cost of installing window shutters will be \$350.00;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves \$350.00 from the Land Claims Youth Recreation Funds to purchase the necessary materials to install window shutters on the community buildings of East Fork and Seven Mile since the community buildings benefit the youth during special recreational activities held in the Community Buildings of East Fork and Seven Mile.

The foregoing resolution was on JULY 10, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
