

RESOLUTION OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, by prior Tribal Council Resolution 83-157, the Tribal Council established an honorarium in the amount of \$200.00 per month for past tribal chairmen; and

WHEREAS, a recent reduction in stumpage income and other financial exigencies mandate that the Tribe severely curtail unnecessary spending; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended to the Tribal Council that the resolution establishing the honorarium should be rescinded until such time as the Tribal Council concludes that said honorarium should be reinstated.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby rescinds Tribal Resolution 83-157 which established an honorarium for past chairmen, until such time as the Tribal Council concludes that said honorarium should be reinstated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that said resolution is effective July 1, 1986.

The foregoing resolution was on July 14, 1986 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to its authority vested in Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
