RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

COMPLETE  
11 SEP 1986

WHEREAS, the sale, use and possession of liquor on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation is cause for concern amongst members of the Tribal Council and tribal people; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council after a lengthy discussion of the uses and abuses of alcohol and its relationship to the economic development of the Tribe in the areas of recreation and retail sales concludes that this complex problem should be investigated by a high level commission who would conduct a study and report back to the tribal council its findings and recommendations; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended that the Commission should be comprised of persons from the Tribal Education Department, Indian Health Service, Fetal Alcohol Syndrome Program, Tribal Attorney's Office, the General Manager of Apache Enterprise, the General Manager of the Sunrise Ski Area, Director of Business Operations and Council Members Kino Kane, Gertie Lupe, and Phillip Stago, Jr; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council requests that the Commission commence its study as soon as possible and report back to the Tribal Council in approximately thirty (30) days.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby establishes a Liquor Commission to study the impact of the sale, use, and possession of alcoholic beverages on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; said Commission to be comprised of representatives from: Tribal Education Department, Indian Health Service, Fetal Alcohol Syndrome Program, Tribal Attorney's Office, the General Manager of Apache Enterprise, the General Manager of the Sunrise Ski Area, Director of Business Operations and Council Members Kino Kane, Gertie Lupe, and Phillip Stago, Jr.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Commission report its findings to the Office of Tribal Chairman and Tribal Council approximately thirty (30) days from receipt of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on August 6, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain


