RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

COMPLETED
11 SEP 1986

WHEREAS, Tribal Member Virginia Massey has requested that the Tribal Council make a decision in respect to a land dispute involving her ancestral lands; and

WHEREAS, said land dispute has been an issue for several years and the Tribal Council concludes that the matter should be finally resolved for the benefit of all concerned; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council upon review of the circumstances and facts surrounding the land dispute concludes that the land presently claimed by Tribal Member Leslie Walker should be relinquished and reassigned to Virginia Massey on the grounds that said land belong to her by ancestral right of occupancy.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby extinguishes all right, title, and claim of Leslie Walker to the ancestral tribal land claimed by Virginia Massey and hereby reassigns said land to Virginia Massey effective this date.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Tribal Land Board to notify Mr. Walker and Mrs. Massey of this resolution and to document and process all papers necessary to transfer said land from Mr. Walker to Mrs. Massey.

The foregoing resolution was on August 6, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and two against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
