RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Shirley Wallen, Director, Food Distribution Program has come before the Tribal Council with a request for Tribal Council authorization to apply for FY 86/87 funding from the U.S. Department of Agriculture, and

WHEREAS, re-application is necessary in order to receive food commodities for the communities of Whiteriver, East Fork/Seven Mile, Canyon Day, Cedar Creek/Carrizo, McNary and Cibecue. In addition, for all tribal members residing in Show Low and Pinetop/Lakeside, and

WHEREAS, the objective of the program is to help improve the diets of the elderly and needy in need of food assistance, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that a sufficient number of tribal members exist who are in need of food and are eligible under the program guidelines.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes Shirley Wallen, Food Distribution Director, to apply for FY 86/87 U.S.D.A. funding for the Food Distribution Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman, and in his absence, the Vice-Chairman to execute any and all documents necessary to apply for and receive funds for the Food Distribution Program.

The foregoing resolution was on August 7, 1986 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
