

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

11 SEP 1986

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Chairman Reno Johnson, Sr., has recommended that Standing Committee's be established without Tribal Council membership in the form attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein; and
- WHEREAS, said list is hereby modified so that the prior Queen Committee members will remain on said Committee to complete plans already underway for the 1986 Miss White Mountain Apache Pageant whereupon they shall be replaced after said pageant; and
- WHEREAS, it is recommended that Kristine (Harvey) Shorty be added to the Queen Committee, that Mr. Devore Thompson be added to the Tribal Fair and Rodeo Commission replacing Council Member Marjorie Grimes and that Glorianna Dayaye be added to the Enrollment Committee to serve in an Advisory capacity; and
- WHEREAS, it is further recommended that the Tribal Attorney review the status of Bureau of Indian Affairs and Indian Health Service employees who have been appointed to the committees to insure that said appointments do not conflict with the Tribal Constitution.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints the attached Standing Committee membership list.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the present Queen Committee membership shall remain until the 1986 Miss White Mountain Apache Pageant is held. That Kristine (Harvey) Shorty be added to the Queen Committee, that Mr. Devore Thompson be added to the Tribal Fair and Rodeo Commission to replace Council Member Marjorie Grimes, and that Glorianna Dayaye be added to the Enrollment Committee to serve in an advisory capacity.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it directs the Tribal Attorney to review the status of IHS and BIA employees who are appointed to the various committees to insure compliance with the Tribal Constitution.

The foregoing resolution was on August 8, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of six for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
