
WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe by tribal resolution number 86-147 approved a Sunrise Dance to be held during the weekend of August 15, 16, 17, 1986 for Mr. and Mrs. Stanley White of East Fork; and

WHEREAS, the tribal members sponsoring and co-sponsoring the Sunrise Dance to be held during the weekend of August 15, 16, 1986 have rescheduled the Sunrise Dance Ceremony to September 26, 27, 28, 1986.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants approval to reschedule the Sunrise Dance sponsored by Mr. and Mrs. Stanley White and co-sponsored by Mr. and Mrs. Leo Nachu to September 26, 27, 28, 1986.

The foregoing resolution was on August 8, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
