

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, lumber is needed in order to complete repairs and renovation of the Cibecue Rodeo grounds; and

WHEREAS, Council Member Marjorie Grimes from Cibecue has requested that the Fort Apache Timber Company donate hog lumber for that purpose and requests Tribal Council authorization for said donation; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with said request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests the Fort Apache Timber Company to donate hog lumber for the repairs and renovation of the Cibecue Rodeo grounds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it requests Council Member Marjorie Grimes to prepare the necessary list of lumber for that purpose and that she provide the Fort Apache Timber Company management with said information.

The foregoing resolution was on August 8, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
