RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

ACCOMPLISHED

11 SEP 1986

- WHEREAS, Garden Park Enterprise, Inc., a non-profit organization that is dedicated to working with mentally handicapped students and their families has been donated a cabin presently located at Hawley Lake by a former leasee whose lease has expired; and
- WHEREAS, said cabin is to be moved to a site near Show Low, but that presently Garden Park Enterprise, Inc. is seeking financial aid to move the home; and
- WHEREAS, the ninety (90) days period set forth in the lease to move homes off the reservation expired July 31, 1986; and
- WHEREAS, Garden Park Enterprise, Inc. has requested that the Tribal Council grant a time extension to remove the cabin so that financial aid can be obtained to move the cabin; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised by Garden Park Enterprise that the cabin will be moved to Showlow for the use of mentally handicapped teens and adults; and
- WHEREAS, based thereon, the Tribal Council concludes that Garden Park Enterprise, Inc. should be granted an extension of time of sixty days in which to move the cabin to the Show Low site; and
- WHEREAS, said cabin has been identified as being located on lot #106 at Hawley Lake.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants Garden Park Enterprise, Inc. an extension of sixty-days, commencing August 1, 1986, in which to remove the cabin located at lot #106 Hawley Lake from the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on August 21, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
