

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

COMPLETED
11 SEP 1986

WHEREAS, the Vice Chairman of the Tribal Council has requested Tribal Council authorization for himself, Milfred Cosen, Tribal Operations Director, and Council Members Herbert Tate and Darvin Burnette to accompany him to the Flathead Reservation on September 4, 5, 6, 1986, for the purpose of inspecting the business operation of the Flathead Pole and Post Company; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with said request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Vice Chairman, Council Members, Herbert Tate and Darvin Burnette, and Milfred Cosen, Tribal Operations Director to travel to the Flathead Reservation to review business operations of the Flathead Pole and Post Company and other tribal enterprises.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the expenditure of tribal funds necessary to finance said business travel.

The foregoing resolution was on August 21, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
