

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has determined the need to improve present road conditions in the South West subdivision by placing river run material thereon for stabilization; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe hereby designates two locations for the material source:

1. From the existing pit below Baptist Church on Route 1; and
2. From a source located just below the old fair grounds in the river area below the Whiteriver Bridge; and

WHEREAS, the southwest subdivision has not been designated to be included in the Bureau of Indian Affairs Road system; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council requests that the Bureau of Indian Affairs include the southwest subdivision within its roads system and that it utilize the river run material from the two locations afore described on the roads in the southwest subdivision to stabilize said roads from erosion.


BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that it hereby requests the Bureau of Indian Affairs to include the Southwest subdivision area in the Bureau of Indian Affairs road system and accomplish the stabilization work with their work force as soon as possible.

The foregoing resolution was on August 21, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
