



RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

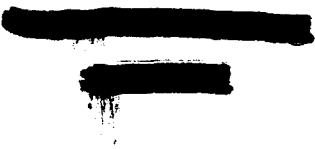
- WHEREAS, the Acting Director of Administration & Finance advises the Tribal Council that he publicly published a notice throughout the reservation advising all concerned, that a second meeting in respect to the use of Revenue Sharing Funds to complete various construction projects and other miscellaneous expenditures as indicated on the attached budget would be held on September 2, 1986 and that said meeting would constitute the second of the three required public meetings necessary prior to the use of Revenue Sharing Funds for the purposes requested; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is further advised that said meeting was held as scheduled; and
- WHEREAS, there was no public opposition at this second public meeting for the allocation of Revenue Sharing Funds for the intended purposes; and
- WHEREAS, it has been publicly published on the reservation, a third notice advising all concerned that the third meeting regarding the use of allocation of Revenue Sharing funds for the attached intended purposes will be held at the Regular Tribal Council Meeting on September 10, 1986 and that said meeting would constitute the third of three required public meetings necessary prior to the use of the Revenue Sharing Funds for the purposes requested; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the expenditures of Revenue Sharing monies as reported on the attached budget request is necessary for the efficient operation of the Tribal Government.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the expenditure of Federal Revenue Sharing Funds in the maximum amount of \$156,000 as previously approved.

The foregoing resolution was on September 10, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 5 for and 3 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the

Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
