WHEREAS, a list of proposed members of the Grievance Committee has been found to be acceptable by the Tribal Council.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Grievance Committee shall be composed of the following persons:


Mary Classay, Chairperson

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Grievance Committee is hereby directed to chose five alternate members to serve as needed in the proceedings of the Grievance Committee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Scott Canty, Assistant Tribal Attorney, is hereby appointed Legal Advisor to the Tribal Grievance Committee.

The foregoing resolution was on September 10, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe Pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
