

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council has previously recognized alcoholism and alcohol abuse as the major health problem of the White Mountain Apache Tribe by Resolution No. 79-16; and

WHEREAS, Mr. T. Secondine, Alcohol Program Coordinator, Indian Health Service, Whiteriver Service Unit, have come before the Tribal Council with a request to present a workshop to the various Tribal Enterprises concerning the benefits of a structured Tribal Employee Assistance Program. The workshop will provide information to the various Tribal Enterprise Managers effective ways of dealing with employees with alcohol/drug problems or any problems which may be affecting the employees job performance. Utilizing the resources that are available to the White Mountain Apache Tribe for such a program will be emphasized; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is agreeable to the proposed workshop presented by Mr. T. Secondine with further arrangement for said workshop, such as time and place to be worked out with Mr. Milfred Cosen, Director of Business Operations and Mr. Anthony Declay, Director of Social Programs.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reaffirms Resolution No. 79-16 and further adopts and supports the proposed Employee Assistance Program Workshop.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it directs the Director of Business Operations, Mr. Milfred Cosen, and Mr. Anthony Declay, Director of Social Programs to cooperate with Mr. T. Secondine in arrangement for Tribal Enterprise Managers to attend the proposed Employee Assistance Program Workshop.

The foregoing resolution was on September 10, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
