

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 86-266 the Tribal Council directed the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority Board of Commissioners to recommend names of candidates to fill the existing vacancy on the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been presented with qualified names of tribal members; and

WHEREAS, after a secret ballot vote of the Tribal Council, it was determined that Mr. Rufus Johnson would fill the vacancy on the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority Board of Commissioners;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Mr. Rufus Johnson to fill the unexpired term of the vacant position on the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority Board of Commissioners effective immediately.

The foregoing resolution was on September 17, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934.
