

RESOLUTION NO. 86-301

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS the Tribal Council has been advised that the Tribal Human Service Center has in the past and presently maintains an independent checking account with First Interstate Bank of Arizona under the name of "World Changers Incorporated", said funds being designated and set aside for the purpose of aiding and assisting children on the reservation; and

WHEREAS the maintenance of this independent checking account by Tribal Human Services has created a situation wherein the White Mountain Apache Tribe had no fiscal control over the funds, and there exist no accountability on the part of the Human Service Center to the tribe in the disposition of these funds; and

WHEREAS the Tribal Council is of the opinion that all funds of whatever nature administered by any tribal entity should come under the direct fiscal control of central tribe; and

WHEREAS First Interstate Bank of Arizona has expressed a willingness to release the funds to the tribe upon tribal council resolution; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that First Interstate Bank of Arizona is hereby authorized to transfer those funds maintained in the "World Changers Incorporated" account held by the bank on behalf of the Tribal Human Services, to a central tribe account to be designated by the Tribal Administrative Manager, for the purpose of subjecting these funds to the central tribe's accounting system; and making Tribal Human Services accountable to the tribe in the disposition of the funds; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is to be the only authorized signator on checks drawn from the account.

The foregoing resolution was on September 17, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
