

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised by Irwin and Edlina (Lupe) Thompson, enrolled members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, that in order to complete the acquisition requirements for a Farmer's Home Administration (FHA) home which they have acquired, a transfer of the homesite lease now in the name of the deceased, Van Declay, must be made to Irwin and Edlina (Lupe) Thompson; and

WHEREAS, the desired homesite being located in the community of Canyon Day and is more particularly described as follows: a parcel of land located in Lot 5 of Sec. 33, T. 5 N., R. 22 E., Gila and Salt River Meridian, Gila County, Arizona containing 0.367 acre; (NW 1/4, SE 1/4, Section 33, T5N, R22E. Canyon Day).

WHEREAS, the lease provisions and the Farmer's Home Administration (FHA) require tribal council approval of such homesite lease transfers from the prior owner to new owner; therefore, Irwin and Edlina (Lupe) Thompson are requesting Council approval of such transfer of the late Van Declay's homesite lease to their name.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the transfer of the late Van Declay Homesite Lease to Irwin and Edlina (Lupe) Thompson in accordance with the lease provisions and the Farmer's Home Administration (FHA) contract guidelines associated with each FHA housing unit.

The foregoing resolution was on September 17, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
