

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, The White Mountain Apache Tribe has contracted with the Bureau of Indian Affairs pursuant to P.L. 93-638 to administer its Law Enforcement and Detention Program; and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to continue striving towards its goal of self sufficiency by providing an efficient and effective police and detention service to the people on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the contract term will be for 12 months beginning with the federal fiscal year on October 1, 1986 and continuing through September 30, 1987; and


WHEREAS, the extent of the contract review will be in accordance to the existing system that is in place for monitoring contracts.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves and authorizes the recontract of the Law Enforcement and Detention Program for FY 86/87.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it requests that the Bureau of Indian Affairs makes every effort to appropriate sufficient funds to minimize the Tribe's financial contribution to the program including appropriating sufficient funds to carry the mandated 19% Indirect Cost Rate to be applied to all such contracts.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman to sign any and all documents necessary to consummate this contract.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b)&(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
