RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Vice-Chairman Alvino Hawkins advises the Tribal Council that tribal member Andy Bennett is in dire need of a house to provide shelter for himself and family; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Bennett is requesting that the Fort Apache Timber Mill donate hog lumber to him to build a house and is requesting Tribal Council approval for said donation; and

WHEREAS, he is requesting one bunk of 2x4, one bunk of 1x12, and one-half bunk of 2 x6; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council approves of said request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Fort Apache Timber Company to provide Mr. Andy Bennett hog lumber as follows: one bunk of 2x4, one bunk of 1x12, and one-half bunk of 2x6.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of eleven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
