

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, tribal member Paul Declay, Sr. has requested through the Office of the Vice Chairman that the old farm office building be donated to him by the Tribal Council for his own use; and

WHEREAS, said building has been vacant and unoccupied for a number of years; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Declay advises the Tribal Council through the Office of the Vice Chairman that he intends to move said building; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees with said request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby gives and transfers to Mr. Paul Declay, Sr. the old farm office building located behind the Human Service Building.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Tribal Attorney's Office to prepare legal documents to transfer ownership of the farm office building to Mr. Paul Declay, Sr.

The foregoing resolution was on November 6, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of eleven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
