RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is concerned about safety on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation and concludes it is necessary to have an overall safety program for the reservation; and

WHEREAS, Safety Officers Ray J. Ivans and Darvin Burnette have been previously authorized to conduct safety investigations and to make recommendations to the Tribal Council in respect to tribal safety programs; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Burnette recommends to the Tribal Council that safety be re-emphasized on the reservation and that the Tribal Council take steps to support the revitalization of a reservation wide safety program; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that a new safety committee should be appointed comprised of Mr. Burnette, Mr. Ivans and Tribal Enterprise Managers and that the Safety Committee should coordinate with non-tribal businesses and federal agencies on the reservation in order to establish a viable on going safety program.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby establishes a tribal safety committee comprised of Mr. Burnette, Mr. Ivans, and the Tribal Enterprise Managers; said committee to be responsible for the establishment of a reservation wide safety program.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs all Enterprise Managers to fully cooperate with Messrs. Darvin Burnette and Ray J. Ivans in the establishment of a tribal reservation-wide safety program and further requests that the Bureau of Indian Affairs cooperate fully with them in such a program.

The foregoing resolution was on November 6, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the
