

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, tribal member Jerry Gooday has requested Tribal Council assistance through Council Member Judy Dehose for a donation of hog lumber adequate to construct a home for himself; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that Mr. Gooday is handicapped and that there is a great need for an adequate home for him.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Manager of Fort Apache Timber Company to provide Mr. Jerry Gooday with sufficient hog lumber to construct a small home for himself.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it further directs the Manager of Fort Apache Timber Company to communicate directly with Council Member Judy Dehose to make the final arrangements for pick up or delivery of the hog lumber.

The foregoing resolution was on November 6, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 11 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
