

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised by Council Member Phillip Stago, Jr., of the necessity of construction a Chain Link Fence around the 7-Mile Community Building to provide security for the 7-Mile Community Building; and



WHEREAS, Council Member Stago has received an estimate from American Fence outlining the cost of the fence construction, the cost being \$3,211.00; and


WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Tribal Council that sufficient funds are on reserve in the 7-Mile Community Land Claim fund held in trust by the Bureau of Indian Affairs to pay for said fence construction; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is of the opinion that the expenditure of the Land Claim funds for the construction of the fence at the community center is an appropriate use of the funds and benefits the 7-Mile Community.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appropriates \$3,211.00 from the 7-Mile Community Land Claim fund held in trust by the BIA for the construction of a fence around the 7-Mile Community Building.

The foregoing resolution was on November 6, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of Eleven for and Zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (s) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
