RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the University of Arizona is willing to sponsor two outstanding high school students who are members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe at the University of Arizona during their college years; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council appreciates this gesture on the part of the University of Arizona and whole heartedly supports such a program.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby accepts and endorses the offer of the University of Arizona to sponsor two top high students from the White Mountain Apache Tribe at the University of Arizona for the September, 1987 school year.

The foregoing resolution was on November 7, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
