

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, from time to time it is necessary for the Tribal Business Office to sell, trade-in or otherwise dispose of tribal government vehicles assigned to the 01 Account; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the Tribal Chairman or his duly authorized representative be empowered to dispose of said vehicles for sale or otherwise; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that said authorization should be granted to the Tribal Chairman or his authorized representative.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants full and complete authority to the Tribal Chairman to sell, trade-in or otherwise dispose of any tribal governmental vehicles under the 01 Account.

The foregoing resolution was on NOVEMBER 7, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT FOR AND ZERO AGAINST by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
