

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, by previous resolution the Tribal Council directed that a proposed amendment to the White Mountain Apache Education Code known as the Truancy Ordinance be posted for public comment as required by the Tribal Constitution for a period of at least ten days; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council Secretary advises the Council that the proposed ordinance has been posted for the requisite constitutional term; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney advises the Council that there has been no opposition to final passage of said ordinance, the final form of which is attached to this resolution and incorporated by reference herein.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves final passage and hereby enacts Ordinance Number 152 known as the White Mountain Apache Education Code in the form and content attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Tribal Council Secretary to distribute copies of this Ordinance to local school officials, the Tribal Education Department, Police Department, and the Tribal Court.


