RESOLUTION NO. 86-362

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, by Tribal Resolution Number 86-325, the Tribal Council unanimously voted to request the Bureau of Indian Affairs of the Fort Apache Agency to develop a gravel road system for Arizona HUD Projects AZ 16-30 and 16-31; and

WHEREAS, the Vice Chairman Alvino Hawkins has requested on behalf of tribal members; Ms. Abigail (Hastings) Yazzie, Mrs. Judy (Moyah) Declay, Ms. Faye Rodriguez and Mr. Wren Cheney, that their names be included in the gravel road plan of the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the above mentioned tribal members currently have dirt roads leading to their homes which are inaccessible by vehicles during inclement weather; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that the tribal members listed herein should be included on the Bureau of Indian Affairs Gravel Road Plan.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the gravel road plan to be devised by the Bureau of Indian Affairs for Arizona HUD Projects AZ 16-30 and 16-31 should also include the names of Ms. Abigail (Hastings) Yazzie, Mrs. Judy (Moyah) Declay, Ms. Faye Rodriguez, and Mr. Wren Cheney.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
