

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Members of the Tribal Council representing the Seven Mile and East Fork Communities have requested Tribal Council approval for the expenditure of \$4,000.00 from the Seven Mile Land Claims Fund, and \$2,000.00 from the East Fork Land Claims Fund, for the purchase of Christmas candy and refreshments for the children and the elderly of those two communities; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with said request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the request of the Tribal Council representatives from East Fork and Seven Mile for the expenditure of \$4,000.00 from the Seven Mile Land Claims Fund, and \$2,000.00 from the East Fork Land Claims Fund for the purchase of Christmas candies and refreshments for children and the elderly of those two communities.

The foregoing resolution was on December 3, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
