

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Assistant Tribal Safety Director, Mr. Darvin Burnette, has requested that the Tribal Council formally request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to paint white divider lines on all of the BIA maintained paved roads within the exterior boundaries of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs in this request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby formally requests the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency to direct the appropriate agency department to paint appropriate dividing lines on all BIA maintained paved roads within the exterior boundaries of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Assistant Tribal Safety Director, Mr. Darvin Burnette, to coordinate this painting program with the BIA roads and maintenance department.

The foregoing resolution was on December 3, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
