

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Tribal Agriculture Enterprise Manager, Mr. Earl Green, advised the Tribal Council general in respect to the proposed Apple Orchard for the Canyon Day Farm; and

WHEREAS, members of the Tribal Council have expressed an interest in visiting the Wilcox area to inspect commercial apple orchards in that area; and


WHEREAS, it is suggested that newly elected Tribal Council members and Council women visit the Wilcox Commercial Apple Orchards prior to Christmas; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Chairman's Office has offered to assist in obtaining the use of a van for transportation to and from the Wilcox area.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes newly elected Tribal Council members and Tribal Council women to travel to Wilcox prior to Christmas for the purpose of inspecting the commercial apple orchards in said area.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Office of the Tribal Chairman to obtain the services of a van to transport said Council Members to Wilcox for the inspection trip.

The foregoing resolution was on December 3, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
