

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is dedicated to improving and upgrading the socio/economic functioning of all its members'; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Elderly Services is the tribal entity charged with providing homecare, advocacy, nutrition, recreation/socialization, transportation and supportive services to elderly tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Elderly Services has identified the need for mobilizing and improving coordination of community resources for the prevention of abuse and neglect of vulnerable elderly tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Elderly Services recognizes the need to identify specific vulnerable elderly tribal members who are predisposed to and are high risk to neglect and abuse; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Elderly Services recognizes the need to establish and implement a model strategy to prevent abuse and neglect of said members with an emergency "shelter" to educate the general public and agencies of such vulnerable elderly services and be a recognized tribal entity within itself; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council recognizes such needs and endorses the intent of the Tribal Elderly Services; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council may authorize the Tribal Chairman to negotiate and execute grants, contracts and amendments thereto.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that it hereby authorizes Tribal Elderly Services to submit a proposal to the Office of Human Development of the United States Department of Health and Human Services for funding to provide and coordinate efforts in providing the aforescribed services to elderly tribal members.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that if said proposal is funded, that the Tribal Elderly Services be the authorized Tribal agency to administer said funds under the program name: IMPROVING TARGETING OF SERVICES TO THE VULNERABLE ELDERLY.


