

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Council Member Judy Dehose from Cibecue has requested that the Tribal Council reaffirm a previous resolution requesting that the Bureau of Indian Affairs Land Operations Department assist in the contouring and landscaping of the Cibecue Landfill in order to alleviate potential health hazards due to its proximity to the Cibecue Rodeo and Fairgrounds; and

WHEREAS, specifically, it is requested that the BIA Land Operations assist in the repair of erosion damage, construct water bars to prevent increased and continual erosion, to attend to the landfill landscaping, and to assist the livestock associations in that area; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs in said request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reaffirms the prior resolution requesting that the BIA Land Operations Department utilize heavy equipment to alleviate the potential health hazards in the Cibecue Landfill, and further requests that the Bureau address the specific problems of erosion, water control, damage to farmland, and general assistance to the livestock associations in said area.

The foregoing resolution was on December 4, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h,i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
