

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, attendance of Tribal Council meetings by tribal employees during working hours is an issue that has been brought to the attention of the Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the Tribal Personnel Department should develop a policy for Tribal Council approval and implementation which would establish guidelines for the attendance by a tribal employee at Tribal Council meetings during working hours.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Personnel Department to propose a policy in respect to attendance of Tribal Council meetings by tribal employees during working hours.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that said proposal should be presented to the Tribal Council for review and consideration at the earliest convenience of the Tribal Personnel Department.

The foregoing resolution was on December 4, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
