

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council by previous resolution requested that BIA Forestry employee, Ken Butler, be transferred to a position outside the Fort Apache Indian Reservation due to complaints that he discriminated against tribal members applying for positions within the BIA Forestry Department under his control; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has again received complaints in respect to Mr. Butler's attitude toward tribal members in respect to hiring practices, and concludes that he has attempted to raise administrative obstacles to tribal members receiving equal opportunity for employment with the Bureau, and has acted contrary to tribal policies and requests that tribal members be given fair and equitable treatment in hiring by the Bureau; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the employment opportunities of tribal members will only improve with the removal or transfer of Mr. Butler from the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that Superintendent Russell Bradley and/or the Phoenix Area Office of the Bureau of Indian Affairs, transfer Mr. Ken Butler from the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Arizona Congressional Delegation and appropriate members of Congress involved with Indian Affairs with a request that their offices inquire into the matter of employment discrimination by the local BIA Agency on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on December 4, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a,i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
