WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised by the Office of the Chairman that the Bureau of Indian Affairs School Board term of Antonette James has expired; and


WHEREAS, it is recommended to the Council that Mrs. James' appointment be renewed on the Agency School Board for an additional term; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with the recommendation.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Ms. Antonette James to the Bureau of Indian Affairs Agency School Board for an additional term.

The foregoing resolution was on December 5, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) (s) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
